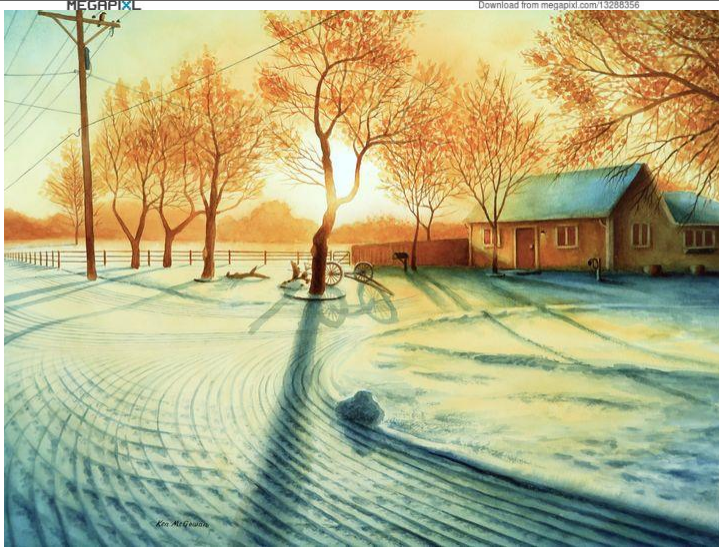
Treasurer position will be overseen by the board.
